



ATTENTION AMATEUR AND NOVICE EXHIBITORS

Any horse exhibited at APHA approved shows or shows sponsored by the APHA, must be owned by the Amateur, or the Amateur's family. Family shall include: spouse, mother, father, son, daughter, brother, sister, grandchild, grandparent, legal ward, inlaws (father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter), stepchild, stepparent, step-grandparent, half brother, half sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew or solely owned corporation, ranch or farm. Such ownership must be evidenced by the records of the APHA.

Horses leased to either the Amateur or the Amateur's family are not eligible for use in APHA approved amateur or novice amateur classes.

AM-020.B. Transfer of Ownership

The exhibitor must be able to prove ownership at the time of the show by presenting the APHA registration certificate or a legible photocopy with the correct owner or owner's name printed on the certificate by the APHA office.

Any horse shown in an amateur or novice amateur class that does not meet this requirement will be disqualified and number of entries will be lowered.
